Debit card fraud is a type of fraud that uses a debit card to immediately withdraw funds from a consumer's account.



Protect Yourself

- Never share your PIN with anyone.
- Notify the bank of telephone, address or email address changes.
- Monitor your account activity.



Remember to contact us if you are travelling out of state or overseas. This will ensure the continued use of your card.



When at the ATM, be aware of your surroundings. Don't count cash at the machine or in public. Be wary of people who offer to help you at the ATM. Watch for people who may look over your shoulder as you enter your PIN.
